Important information from the school office

Day school attendance- If

your child will be absent for any part of the regular school day, please email

attendance@sjsmarysville.org or call 937-644-5540 and let us know no later than 9 a.m. We will need the child's name, grade and the reason for the child's absence.

Please note that in order for an absence to be considered "excused" a signed parent note or medical excuse is required when the student returns to regular

classes per our school handbook.

The state of Ohio is now tracking *hours* of attendance rather than *days*. The state guidelines are as follows:

Excessive Absence is defined as 38 or more hours missed in one school month and 65 hours in one school year.

This applies to hours missed for tardies, early dismissals and time missed with or without legitimate excuse.

Habitual Truancy is defined as 30 or more consecutive hours missed, 42 hours missed in one school month, or 72 hours in a school year without legitimate excuse.

Transportation- Please communicate a regular dismissal

pattern for your student with your child's homeroom teacher.

**If your child's transportation will deviate from their regular schedule on any particular day, a written note, e-mail communication to office@sjsmarysville.org or verbal communication no later than 2pm is a necessity!

Otherwise he/she must be transported as usual.




