
As we continue to steward what is His, remember that no matter what, you too can make a difference!!!








# Fall Field Trip Fun

St. John's will ONLY follow the calamity schedule of the **Fairbanks school district**; when it comes to weather related delays or cancellations.

To stay informed, tune to any of the local news channels on the television and or local radio stations. Look or listen for Fairbanks Local School District. St. John's will also send out a text, voice messages, and Email alerts through FACTS so please ensure your contact information is up to date!

your child in as you see fit. We do not
delay this particular portion of our
ministry because these students do
not use public school busing.



# Not feeling well?

To minimize the danger of spreading disease parents are asked to keep their children home if they have bad colds or other infections. St. John's Lutheran School and the Ohio Department of Education endorse the following practices when your child is ill:

• Keep your child home from school and school activities for at least 24 hours after their fever is gone. (Fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) A fever is defined as 100°F or higher.

- If your child vomits or has diarrhea, he/she should not return to school for 24-48 hours.
- If your child has a noticeable infection (colored runny noses, excessive tearing/mucus in eyes, etc., please seek the advice of your family physician before bringing your child to school).

   call 937-644-5540 and let us know:
   a) between 7:45 and 9:00 a.m. b)
   Give us the child's name, grade,
   and teacher's name. c) The reason
   for the child's absence.
- Send a note to school with your child when they return to regular classes (this is required by Ohio Law). By calling us or emailing, you will be helping us protect the children as the law intends without needless hours of extra work. THANK YOU!
